### **Message from the President**

Dear Friends.

We are rapidly coming to the end of another year. This year has been a very challenging one for almost all of us. The excitement that greeted us at the beginning of the year, was rapidly eroded by the deleterious effects of a Covid-19 pandemic. This has produced a lot of illnesses, deaths, loss of jobs and income, uncertainties and the fear of the unknown. The fact that a virus could turn our lives upside down, creating such a havoc on humanity is another reminder of how finite our presence on this earth is. Our bodies are here today and could be gone tomorrow. Having good health and maintaining it is a gift of God. The assurance and promise of an eternal life in Christ Jesus is a great blessing.

Despite these, we are very thankful to God for seeing us through another year. We made only one trip to Ghana this year, making it the 36th Mission trip. Unfortunately, we could not share details of this trip with you previously in this newsletter because we did not publish in the summer. We are glad we could share some parts of the experiences with you.

During our trip, we trained staff, saw patients and started construction of the Women and Children's Clinic at Worgbato, a village 5 miles away from the hospital. Women in this village will now have the chance to deliver in a safe and hygienic condition. Our goal is to reduce maternal death and complications associated with childbirth in an extremely poor community.

The pandemic also affected the work of the IHDN Mission Hospital. Our dedicated staff are making great sacrifices as they work under extreme financial pressures. Attendance at the hospital declined by 40% for the greater part of the year until recently, when it started to pick up. Our cash flow and internally generated funds have also declined accordingly.

Several of you continue to support us on this journey. This has been a big encouragement for our efforts. We also welcome your prayers, and the support of those yet to join us in this effort to advance God's kingdom and be a blessing to the poor and disadvantaged among us.

We thank you for believing in us. We wish you and your family a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

- 4. Construction work on the Women & Children's Clinic & Staff Apartment
- 5. Community Screening for high blood pressure
- 6. Training on Basic Life Support (BLS)

## **Money Matters**

One of the unique characteristics of IHDN is that we have a lot of activities going on outside the United States. Until recently, we were providing medical care for over 30,000 patients at the IHDN Mission Hospital each year, with a staff of 100, including 3 doctors. However, most of the funding and support comes from the US, without which we would not be able to continue with what we do. In 2014 we started the construction of a 5-storey, 30 units, staff apartment and this year the Women and Children's Clinic. We have spent over one million dollars, including \$147,607 this year on the almost completed apartment. We thank all of you for supporting our efforts.
